



Lego Contest Rules and Guidelines

1. Use your own Lego, Duplo, Mega Bloks or other Lego compatible plastic brick.
2. Entries must be your own creation, not a Lego designed kit, project found online, in a magazine, etc. and limited to the category for your age group as detailed below. A paragraph explaining your project should be included with your display.
3. Your creation must be on a base no bigger than 24 x 24 inches. The base can be wood, cardboard, a LEGO flat base, etc. and can be decorated to fit with your project. Your completed project may be no taller than 4 feet tall.
4. No other materials (glue, paper, etc.) are permitted in the creation of your entry.
5. Prizes will be awarded in each age category as listed below.
6. One entry per participant or team where applicable.
7. Team projects will be placed in the category of the oldest participant on the team.
8. Fill in the attached entry form and submit it with your entry.
9. Completed project must be delivered to IRMC Park beginning at 4:00 p.m. and the last entry accepted at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 8th.
10. Judging will be conducted on Wednesday, June 8th beginning at 5:30 p.m. and winners announced shortly after 6:30 p.m.
11. Completed entries MUST be taken home immediately after the event conclusion, approximately 7:30 p.m. Although some designs may be asked to be displayed in local stores in Downtown Indiana and can be displayed there through June 20th.
12. The decision of the judges is final.
13. Every effort will be made to return all bricks to their original owner.
14. Only one entry per participant.

Participants in ALL age categories are encouraged to include a **brief written description** with their creation. High School & Adult categories may include a **written description, as well as operational instructions and initial design drawings.**

Categories

0 - 4 Years	Duplo or Mega Blok Creations
5 - 8 Years	Transportation Theme
9 - 11 Years	Buildings (<i>Hospital, office, home, etc.</i>)
12 - 14 Years	Entertainment in IRMC Park (<i>What could you do in IRMC Park; amusement, event, show, etc.</i>)
15 - 18 Years	Machines with a Purpose
19+ Years	Indiana in 2116

Prizes

Each first place winner will receive a \$25.00 gift certificate from a local store.

A People's Choice Award will also be presented to one winner in **each** category.
The People's Choice Award prize will be a LEGO kit.
